

Polar Rose Widget

1. Embed and configure the widget script

Invoke the widget by including this script tag in the head or body of your HTML document:

```
<script type="text/javascript" src="http://cdn.widget.polarrose.com/polarrosewidget.js"
config="optin:'polarrose', hover:false, resource:'[path_to]polarrosewidget.html'"></script>
```

The example above will process all images on the page that have a class of "polarrose" (ie.) and show roses on images where faces are detected.

Configuration options

- 1.1 – optin:** An optional string value. The widget will only process images with the declared class name. If not present the widget will process all images.
- 1.2 – hover:** An optional boolean value. Default is "false" ie. roses are always visible. If "true" roses are only shown when mouse hovers over the image.
- 1.3 – resource:** An required string value (URL). The resource URL should be the location of the polarrosewidget.html file on your server (see point 2.2 below).

2. Create and upload the polarrosewidget.html file

- 2.1 – Create** a blank (empty) text file and name it "polarrosewidget.html"
- 2.2 – Upload** this file to your server.

IMPORTANT: the URL that the polarrosewidget.html file is served from must be part of the same domain as the pages containing the images you want the widget to process. We recommend the root of the folder that your website is served from.
